There are no refunds once your test is scheduled, but you can call 24 hours prior to your test date to reschedule at no charge. Subjects include Reading Comprehension, Math, and Critical Thinking. You have 2.5 hours to complete all three tests. Testing for the PCT/MA class includes math and reading only.

Testing dates are subject to change, if you go to the website to schedule your test date and the desired test date is grayed out, that means the testing date is full or has been cancelled. Please choose another date or another location to test. Be sure to get a head start and schedule your test early so that you have time to take and pass your test prior to the deadlines. There is no waiting period to test if you do not get your desired score the first time. You can test as many times as you want in order to get the highest score possible to increase your chances of acceptance into the Health Occupations programs.
