Dear TCAT Jackson Student,

In 2013 it was signed into law an expanded version of the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) that includes the Campus Sexual Violence Elimination (SaVE) Act. This Act requires colleges and universities to have and disclose procedures to respond to reports of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking (<https://tcatjackson.edu/about/safety-and-security>). The SaVE Act requires all Title IV institutions to provide primary and ongoing sexual assault awareness and prevention training to all students. Additionally, legislation was passed and became effective July 1, 2016 that requires all incoming freshmen/new students to participate in sexual assault training.

In compliance with the SaVE Act and the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act (EDGAR Part 86), and in an effort to better advance our students beyond the classroom, we have partnered with EverFi to provide a sexual assault awareness and prevention course called **Haven**, along with an alcohol awareness program called **AlcoholEdu** for all entering students. These courses are used in conjunction with each other to better inform students of their rights, responsibilities and repercussions based on their actions and/or the actions of others. You will need to complete the following online courses: **Haven, AlcoholEdu** and **Transit**. These courses will help you develop the critical life skills to make more thoughtful and educated choices outside the classroom. Our hope is that with these skills you will find greater success both here at TCAT Jackson and beyond.

The course may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure students' attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are confidential; the college will only receive information about the student body as a whole and will never see individual student answers.
