Sexual Assault and Transit Online Course



Dear TCAT Jackson Student,

In 2013, the President of the United States signed into law an expanded version of the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) that includes the Campus Sexual Violence Elimination (SaVE) Act. This Act requires colleges and universities to have and disclose procedures to respond to reports of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking (<http://tcatjackson.edu/annual-security-report>). The SaVE Act prevention training to all students.

In compliance with the SaVE Act and the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act (EDGAR Part 86), and in an effort to better advance our students beyond the classroom, we have partnered with EverFi to provide a sexual assault awareness and prevention course called **Sexual Assault**, along with the **Transit Awareness program**, for all entering students to participate in. These courses are used in conjunction with each other to better inform students of their rights, responsibilities and repercussions based on their actions and/or the actions of others, and their financial responsibilities. You will need to complete the **Sexual Assault**, a two hour (2) hour online course, and the **Transit**, a forty-five-minute course. These courses will help you develop the critical life skills to make more thoughtful and educated choices outside the classroom. Our hope is that with these skills you will find greater success both here at TCAT Jackson and beyond.

- You will need a valid email address that you check often.
- You will need Internet access and/or audio capabilities. Each program will allow you to use the transcript video, for reading, instead of the audio.
- To avoid technical issues, please use any major web browser (e.g., Firefox, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome) released within the previous two years.
- You may take the course in multiple sittings. If you do not have computer access, contact Ms. Rebekah White-Williams at 731-424-0691 Ext. 129.
- The course may include surveys to help personalize your experience and measure students' attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are confidential; the school will only receive information about the student body as a whole and will never see individual students' answers.

- Complete the Part 1 (3 to 3 ½ hours to complete all three required courses). After 10 days, you will receive an email to complete Part 2 of the Everfi courses.
