Purpose:

- Access and Diversity COVID-19 funds must be used to cover pandemic-related costs. Such expenses may include hardware/software costs incurred due to a change in training modalities, internet access fees, or other unexpected educational costs related to the student's cost of attendance. Students must provide supporting documentation to prove that a need exists.
- Funds will be used to promote underrepresented or non-traditional students in pursuing technical education and to support students in a training program where one gender comprises a small percentage of the individuals employed in that field of work.

Application Requirements:

- Completed Application
- Narrative from applicant explaining how funds would be used
- Complete a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and provide required documentation if chosen for verification

Award: Cannot exceed 100% of published cost of tuition/fees and books/supplies for the trimester. Award will be determined based on the outstanding balance after financial aid has been applied to the student's account. Award amount is **\$1000** per student.

Scholarship Duration: The TCAT Access and Diversity Scholarship (COVID-19) is a non-renewable scholarship. The scholarship recipient must be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress as established in the TCAT Jackson Student Handbook.

Application Deadline:

August 1 for Fall term (September) December 1 for Spring term (January) April 1 for Summer term (May)

Selection of the TCAT Access and Diversity Scholarship (COVID-19) recipients will be based on the following criteria:

- TCAT Academic Record
- Documented Financial Need
- Character

The selection of the recipient shall be the responsibility of a committee designated by the Financial Aid Coordinator. All applications are confidential and the property of TCAT Jackson/Whiteville. These funds will be handled by the TCAT Jackson business office.

The scholarship recipient is required to attend school on a full-time basis (30 clock hours weekly). The recipient may participate in the cooperative education program if approved by the program instructor.
